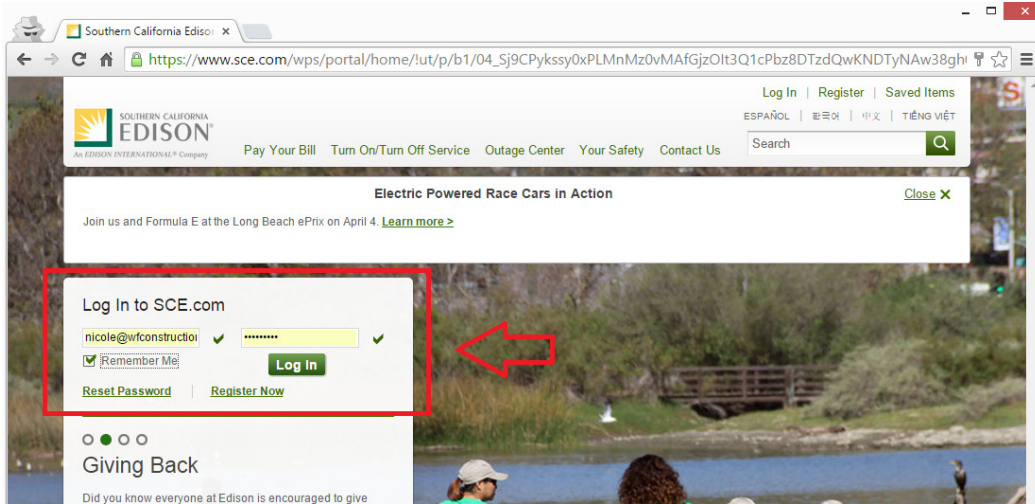
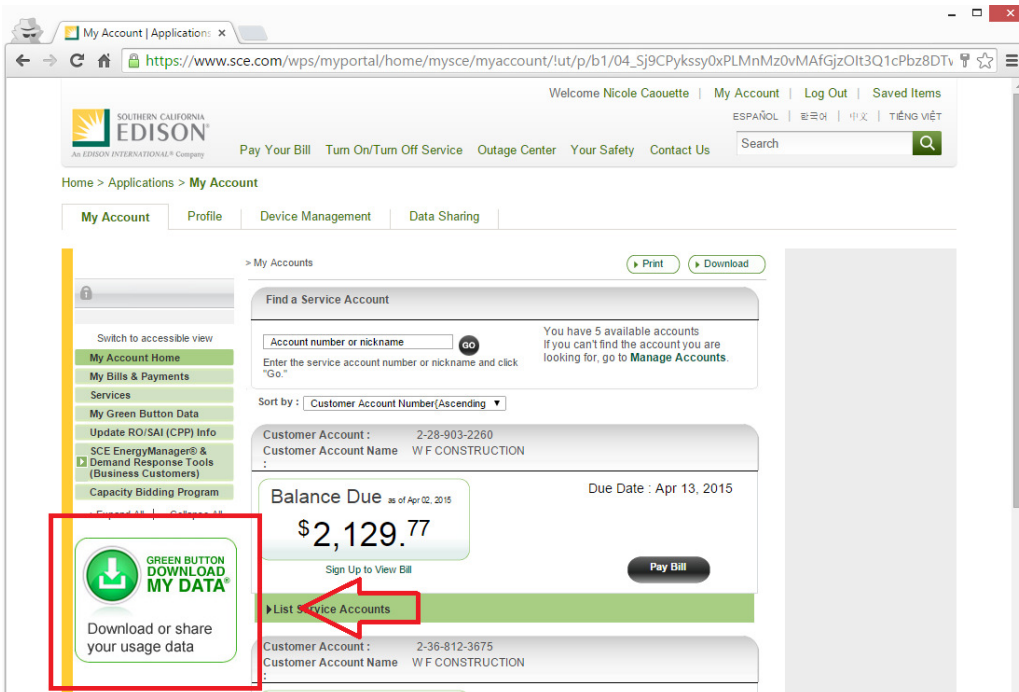


SCE – Green Button Data, download instructions

- (1) Go to the Southern California Edison website: www.sce.com
- (2) Sign in using User ID & Password
 - a. If you don't already have an account, you need to register using your account number.



- (3) Click on the 'Green Button – Download My Data' icon, in the left side menu.



- (4) Set the date range (ideally you want 365 days of recent data).
- (5) Select the 'XML Format (.xml)' from the 'Download Format' drop-down menu.
- (6) Click the 'Download' button (the SCE site usually takes a minute to download the file).

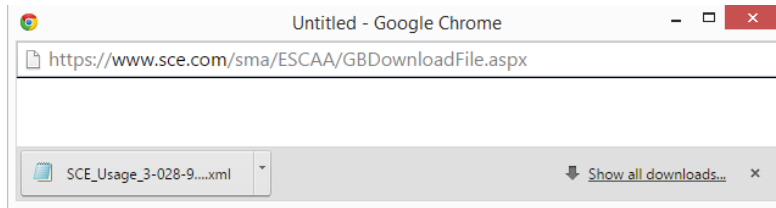

(8) Alternatively, in a Chrome browser you can always hit "Ctrl + J" to open you Downloads folder, where you will see your recently downloaded files.

(9) The '.xml' file may download in a compressed Zip file format.

- a. If you're going to be emailing the Green Button Data file, email it the Zip file format to keep the size compressed.
- b. To extract the '.xml' file from the Zip folder > save the Zip file to your desktop, then right-mouse-click on the Zip file to 'Extract'.
